

# **10-Day Glimpse of China** BEIJING • XI'AN • SHANGHAI Travel Date: Mar 10-19, 2015

Day 1: Arrive at Los Angeles Airport for check in. Day 2: LOS ANGELES TO BEIJING Board Air China and fly to Beijing. Cross the international dateline.

### DAY 3: BEIJING (L)
